

3D Photo Frame By Tanya Batrak



Inspiration: IndigoBlu has so many beautiful stamps. These giant poppies are gorgeous, and I decided to use them as a main décor on my frame.

Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Warm Sunset (YO3); Spring Meadow (YG3); Bubble Gum (PK3); Crimson Red (RD4); Indigoblu Giant Poppy A5 Red Rubber Stamp by Kay Halliwell-Sutton (IND0177); Indigoblu Colour Me - Dahlia A6 Red Rubber Stamp by Kay Halliwell-Sutton (IND0243); Indigoblu Colour Me - Daisy A6 Red Rubber Stamp by Kay Halliwell-Sutton (IND0244); watercolor paper; vellum; Dear Lizzy sticker

Instructions:

1. Stamp images several times on a watercolor paper. These IndigoBlu poppies stamps are very big so it's better to use Misti tool for a perfect result.



2. Color each image with the brush tip using Warm Sunset, Spring Meadow, Bubble Gum, Crimson Red infusing each color before coloring for 3 seconds.



3. Using the fine point scissors trim the colored images. Cut three frames 15x15 cm, the inner square is one cm smaller. Adhere colored images of the Dahlia and Daisy IndigoBlu stamps on one of the frames. Adhere a piece of 15x15 cm vellum over this

frame. Adhere a piece of vellum, some cut images and a photo on the other frame, and the biggest flower on the third frame.

4. Cut four 8x15 cm pieces of water color paper and fold each 1 cm accordion folds. Use a ruler and a pencil to mark out 1 cm alongside the top and bottom of your piece of paper. Then use those marks as guides for your accordion folds. You will see, that those folds make slots. Now take the frame covered with vellum, line its left side up to your paper accordion, and put it in the back-most “slot” of the accordion, adhere them together. Take the other paper accordion, line it up to the right side of the frame and adhere. Repeat this step with the other two frames, putting them in the middle and front slots accordingly. Adhere the last two paper accordions on the top and the bottom of the frame.
