

## Celebrate 4th July by Leah Cornelius



Inspiration:- Celebrating the Fourth of July is always fun for our family and my kids love to get a new pinwheel each year, so I thought a celebratory card featuring them in patriotic colors was a great way to add to the fun!

Materials Used:- Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Crimson Red (RD4), Royal Blue (BL6), Inspired By Stamping Swirly Pinwheels stamp set, Impression Obsession Celebrate stamp set, Memento Tuxedo Black ink, Sticky in Waterfall and Burgundy, Recollections white cardstock, sequins.

Instructions:-

- i. Stamp pinwheel images onto cardstock and color them using Crimson Red (RD4) and Royal Blue (BL6) and the brush nib infusing for 12 seconds on the large pinwheels and 8 seconds on the small one. Trim the pinwheels out.



- ii. Arrange the pinwheels onto the card to determine where to stamp the handles. Trim a piece of cardstock into a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " strip and stamp the sentiment onto it. Set aside the pinwheels and the sentiment strip.

- iii. On the card base stamp the banner with stars several times. Adhere the pinwheels to the card. Gently lift up on each flap to create added dimension. Adhere the sentiment strip and embellish with Stickles and sequins.
