

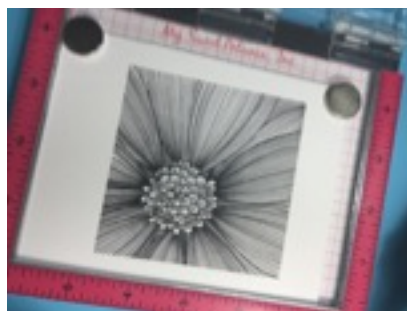


Inspiration: The shaker cards have been pretty popular lately, so I decided to use this stamp to create shaker card and fill it with sequins/beads mix

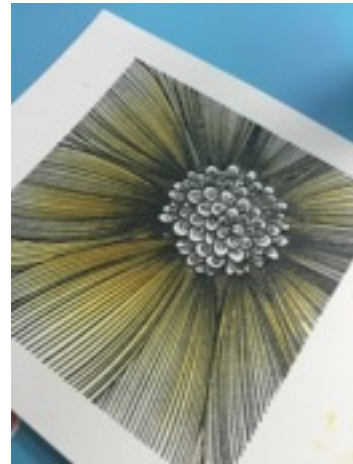
Materials Used:- Chameleon Pens Deluxe Set, Indigo Blu Color Me Daisy cling stamp, MISTI, Versafine Onix Black, Clear embossing powder, heat gun, Stampin' Up! Layering squares framelits, Neenah white card stock, Black card stock, acetate sheet, Spectrum Noir sparkle pen in Gold, Mama Elephant die Thanks.

Instructions:

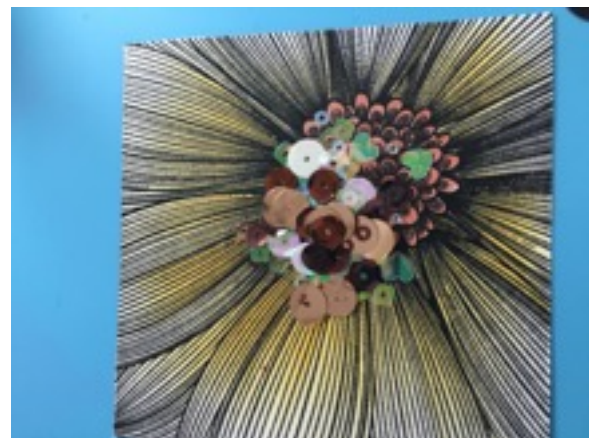
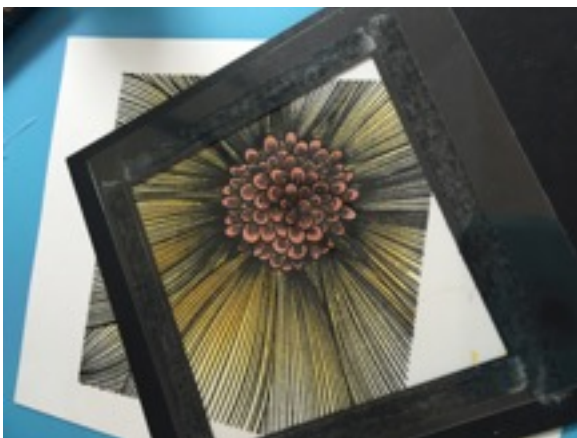
1. Stamp your image using versafine ink and the MISTI tool onto the white card stock. Stamp it couple times so you have even coverage and nice intense black. Then using clear embossing powder emboss the image.



2. Color the image using Warm Sunset, Bark and Hot Cocoa pens. Start with the petals and the Warm Sunset pen. Infuse the brush nip with the toning medium for 17-18 seconds and color section of the flower, repeat the process until you have colored all petals. Next color the center with the Bark and Hot Cocoa pens without infusing them. I colored the little centers using the Bark pen, then I colored the whole center and blending in the Bark color with the Hot Cocoa Marker.



3. Cut the front panel and then using a square die cut a window. Adhere acetate on the back. Then adhere foam tape around the window. Pour sequins mix in the middle of the image and then adhere the card front to it making sure the edges are nice and secure so that the sequins don't fall off.



4. Cut three times the sentiment from black card stock and adhere them all together, then "color" them using the Sparkle pen. Adhere to shaker panel and adhere some sequins. To finish the card adhere it to black top folding card base.
