

Storage Barrel by Olesya Kharkova



Materials Used:- Arc Crafts Sticky BARC Cherry; brown acrylic paint, gold acrylic paint, cracking varnish for art and crafts, Prima Marketing white flowers Innocence2, burlap material, natural twine, phrasal stickers, die cuts, sequins, cup type container, Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Fawn (NU3), Spring Meadow (YG3), Summer Sun (YL2), Warm Sunset (YO3).

Instructions:-

1. Find some cup type container with a hanger. Wash it thoroughly and leave it to dry.



2. Apply one coat of brown acrylic paint all around the cup and leave it to dry.

3. Make sure that the previous coat is dry and apply one coat of gold acrylic paint.



4. Let the cup dry thoroughly. Cover the whole piece with cracking varnish following the instructions on the bottle. Dry this coat and apply one more coat of brown acrylic paint on top moving in one direction. Once dry the gold cracks will appear.



5. Sew a small burlap sack to fit the inner part of the cup.



6. Measure the height of the cup and cut Arc Crafts Sticky BARC Cherry sheet in stripes 2cm wide and adhere them to the cup. Take the Fawn (NU3) pen and color the edges of the stripes with a brush nib.

7. Unfold the top part of the burlap and cover the upper edges of the cup. Adhere a small burlap border to decorate the bottom part. Take some natural twine and wind it several times around the cup in two places.



8. Take a white Prima Marketing flower (Innocence 2) and color the bottom parts of all the petals with the brush nib of the Warm Sunset pen without infusing then blend it with the Summer Sun pen infused for 5 seconds and using the brush nib, moving from the top parts of the petals to the bottom.



9. Using the brush nib of the Spring Meadow pen infused for 5 seconds color the die cut leaves moving from the top to the bottom. Sponge other die cut pieces with Antique Linen distress ink.

10. Add some phrasal stickers and sequins to embellish the barrel.
