



Materials Used: Chameleon Pens: 5 Skin Tones Nude (NU00), Sand (NU0), Light Peach (NU2), Caramel (NU4), Burnt Umber (BR4) and Bubblegum (PK3) Some Odd Girl: Miss You Mae, Lawn Fawn Ink pads Doe, Walnut and Soot, Memento Tuxedo Black ink pad, Neenah white card-stock, American Crafts foam adhesives, Fine scissors, May Arts burlap string, Misti Stamping tool.

Instructions:

Stamp image and color using all five of the skin tones 5 piece collection. Color the image infusing each section for 5 seconds.
Blend colors using dark to light.
Trim image leaving a hint of white and set aside.



Stamp all the flowers using colored ink pads. Trim each flower leaving a hint of white.

Cut a piece of card-stock slightly smaller than card and stamp flower image in random places.



Flower Power Project

Using foam adhesives take the cut flower images and fill in the white space of background.



Using foam adhesives take trimmed image and adhere to card.



Adhere to card base designer paper and image background. Wrap burlap string around top base.
