



Materials Used:- Chameleon Pens Dark Sage and Peony Pink, Arc Wood sheet, Illustrated Faith Blessings or Lessons kit, Versamark ink pad, Hero Arts Gold embossing powder, Heat tool, sequins, Nuvo golden drops, MISTI , 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" shadow box frame.

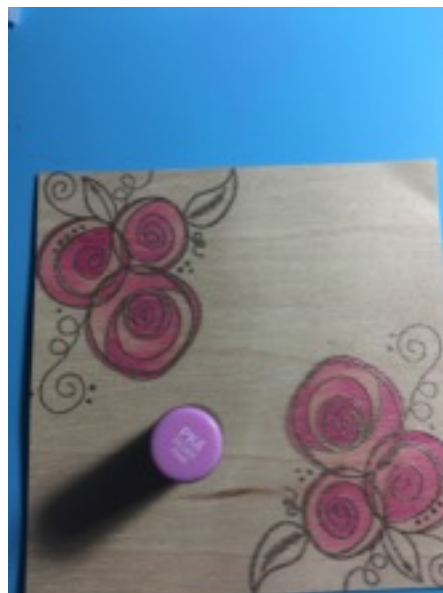
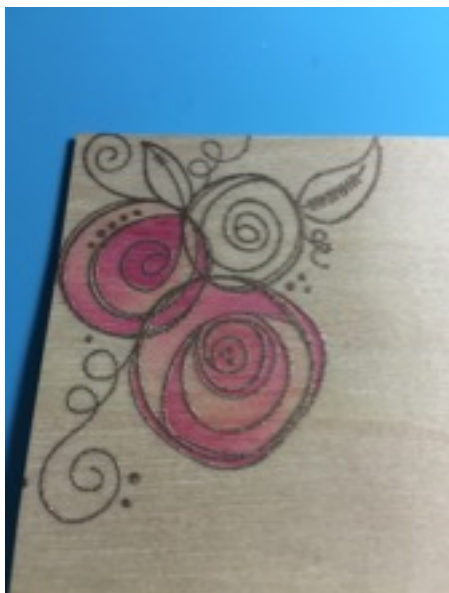
Instructions:

1. Cut the sheet of Arc wood down to 4 1/2" x 4 1/2", then stamp your image using Versamark ink and with help of stamp positioner to make sure you have even spacing and they are at exact same place in both corners. Next apply gold embossing powder and heat set it.



2. Color the images using the Peony Pink and Dark Sage pens.

For the flowers use the Peony Pink pen and infuse the brush nib for 4-5 seconds with the toning medium. And color each part of the flowers. Note that when coloring on wood sheets you need shorter infusion time. For the leaves use Dark Sage pen and infuse the brush nib of it for about 2-3 seconds using the toning medium, then color each leaf.



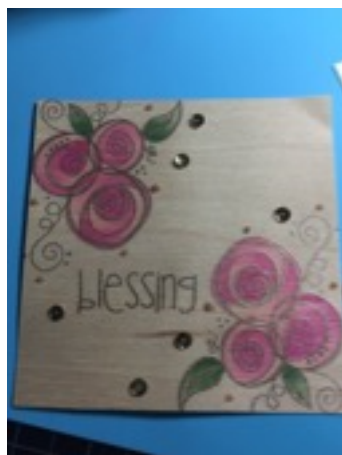


Repeat the infusion process for each leaf and each flower part.

3. Stamp the sentiment in versamark and emboss it using gold embossing powder.



4. Add sequins and Nuvo drops to finish up your art piece and let the Nuvo drops dry.



5. Insert your wood sheet into to shadow box frame.
