Tissue Box by Leah Cornelius



Materials Used:- Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Grass Green (GR3), Summer Sun (YL2), Purple Grape (PR4), Deep Violet (V04), Bark (BR5), Arc Crafts Barc Wood Cherry, Inspired By Stamping Australian Nature I stamp set, Spellbinders Nestabilities Classic Ovals large dies, Memento Tuxedo Black ink, Recollections white cardstock, twine.

Instructions:-

i. Find a small facial tissue box and measure the sides and top. For the top find a die that will match up to the opening and die cut where the tissue with come out. Cut all the Arc Wood pieces and adhere to the tissue box. Using Bark (BR5) and the brush nib with pure color fill in any seams that are visible so that they blend with the wood sheets. Set aside.



ii. Choose an image you want for your tissue box and stamp into onto white cardstock. Begin by coloring the leaves using Grass Green (GR3) and the brush nib infusing for 8 seconds and color from the tips down to the stem.

iii. Use Summer Sun (YL2) and the brush nib with pure color to color the very center of the flowers.Using Purple Grape (PR4) and the brush nib infuse for 5 seconds and color the inner petals.



iv. Using Deep Violet (V04) and the brush nib infuse between 5 and 10 seconds varying the light and shadow on the petals. Go over with pure color where veins are indicated.



v. Adhere the colored image to the tissue box and embellish by wrapping twine around it and tying in a bow.
