

Dare to Dream Picture by Cathy Andronicou



Materials used: Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Cinnamon (BR3), Dusty Rose (PK2), Bisque (NU1), The Crafters Workshop stencil Mini Dream Girl; Strathmore Artist Tile, Design Memory Craft Gelato Gold and Orange, Masking Tape, Dreamweaver Black Gloss Embossing Paste, Imaginecrafts Palette Knife, Ranger Gesso, Alphabet Stamps and Versafine Onyx Black Ink and Memento Rich Cocoa Ink. Pico Clear embellisher.

Instructions:

1. Place stencil onto artist tile and mask off areas leaving face exposed.

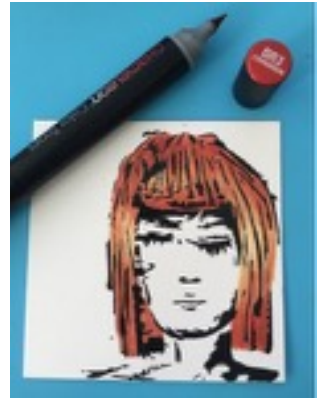


2. Apply embossing paste to stencil, scrape off excess back into pot and remove stencil and clean immediately. Leave to dry.

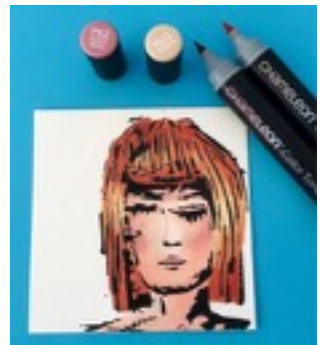


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3. Colour hair using Cinnamon Chameleon pen (fuse the bullet nib for 15 seconds each time and work with a flicking motion from the light areas to the darker areas of the hairline).



4. Colour the face using bisque and dusty rose, fuse the pens or 8 seconds and color sections working from highlight to dark each time you fuse the pen.



5. Add distress bubbles using gesso to side of face.



6. Color edges of card with Gelato Crayons.



7. Use a sponge applicator with some water to remove some of the color through the stencil.



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- Stamp sentiments and then edge with rich cocoa ink. Then add Pico clear embellisher, leave to dry.



- Add sentiments to design to finish, mount into a frame.
