



Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tone Pens; Red Coral (RD2), Tangerine (OR3), Evergreen (GR4), Detail Pen, Altenew Beautiful Day Stamp and Die set, Versafine Teal Zeal Ink, Memento Pear Tart ink, Stamping Up Cameo Coral Ink, Martha Stuart Doily Border punch, Turquoise Linen Card, Bee Paper, Glue and Foam Pads.

Instructions:-

1. Stamp 3 flowers Using the outline and shadow stamp onto Bee paper using Cameo Coral ink and die cut.



2. Use the brush nib of the Red Coral pen and fuse for 10 seconds then color each petal individually, working from the light areas towards the dark. Then change over to the bullet nib and fuse for 5 seconds and add texture to each petal by flicking into the highlighted area from the dark areas.



- Stamp the leaves 3 times using pear tart ink and die cut using the corresponding die.



- Fuse the brush nib of the Evergreen pen and color from the tip of the leaf towards the base. Then add texture by fusing the bullet nib for 5 seconds and adding strokes from the centre of the leaf towards the edge.



- Stamp sentiment using Versafine Ink, cut lace edge from white card and then attach to turquoise card folded into zig zag shape. Attach flowers and leaves using glue and foam pads.
