



Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tone Pens; Tangerine (OR3), Green Apple (GR1), Lavender (BV2), Altenew Beautiful Day Stamp set, Versafine Onyx Black Ink, Memento Tuxedo Black ink, Crealies Stitched Square die, Tattered Lace Card Shapes Squares Die, Lavender Linen Card, Bee Paper, Pearls Post it Note and Glue.

Instructions:-

1. Stamp flower using the outline stamp onto Bee paper using Memento Tuxedo Black ink, then stamp again onto a post it note and cut around the edge (this will be your mask)



2. Place the post it note over the stamped flower and then stamp the smaller flower spray and leaves around the edge.



- Color the main flower using the Tangerine pen, fuse the brush nib for 10 seconds and then color from the area to be highlighted into the shaded areas. Then add texture by fusing the bullet nib for 5 seconds and adding flicks from the dark areas colored into the light areas.



- Fuse the brush nib of the Lavender pen for 10 seconds and color individual flowers, hop around so that you get variation of color on each flower.



- Color the leaves with Green Apple, fusing the brush nib for 5 seconds and then coloring from the tip of the leaves towards the base.



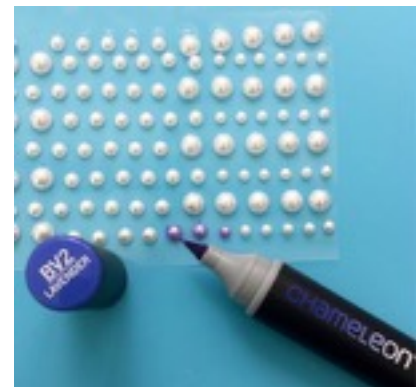
- Cut out image using the Crealies stitched circles die and then stamp the sentiment using Versafine Onyx Black ink.



7. Die cut card base from Lavender card using Tattered Lace Card Shapes Squares and then attach stamped panel.



8. Color pearls using lavender pen and adhere to card.
