

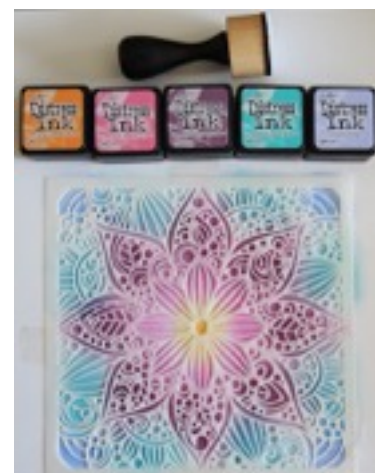
Pink Flower Stencilled Card by

Materials Used: Chameleon Pens: Bubble Gum (PK3), Purple Grape (PR4), Deep Black (BK4); TCW631s Mini Doodle Bloom stencil by Valentina Harper (TCW); Stuck on You stamp set (Lawn Fawn); Versamark ink pad; White embossing powder; Distress Ink pad: Spiced Marmalade, Picked Raspberry, Seedless Preserves, Peacock Feathers, Shaded Lilac; Distress Blending Tool; Neenah Solar White card; 12"x12" Velvet Bazzill Basic Paper; Black cardstock; Stitched Borders (Lawn Fawn Cuts), S4-161 Labels One (Spellbinders Nestabilities); Stylus tool; Half pearl bead.

Instructions:

1. Adhere the stencil on a sheet of Neenah paper with adhesive tape, then blend the Distress ink in order as shown in the picture.

2. Adhere again the stencil onto another piece of Neenah paper and outline the central flower with a fine tip pencil. Complete the petals drawing.



3. Color the petals with Bubble Gum pen, infusing the brush nib for 10 seconds each. Add some strips in the inner of the petals with the Purple Grape pen: infuse the bullet nib for 4-5 seconds for each petal. Then cut out the flower.



4. Bend the petals using the Stylus tool, then glue the flower onto the center of the stenciled paper. Add an half pearl bead in the middle coloring it with the Black Deep pen.

5. Trim the stenciled paper and add a stitched frame using the Stitched Borders die. Glue it onto a 6<sup>1/4</sup>"x6<sup>1/4</sup>" (16,5 x 16,5 cm) piece of Velvet Bazzill paper adding the black piece of cardstock with the white embossed sentiment in between. Attach all onto a white card base.
