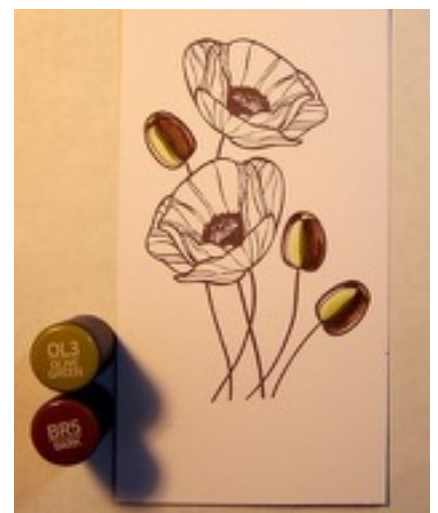
Materials Used:- Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Olive Green (OL3), Bark (BR5), Bubble Gum (PK3), Summer Sun (YL2), The Crafter's Workshop stencils; Mini Poppy Garden, Mini Chickadee Post and Mini Life Words, Technique Tuesday Budding Poppies stamp set, Distress Ink in: Bundled Sage, Spun Sugar, Squeezed Lemonade, Walnut Stain, Memento Rich Cocoa ink, Ranger mini foam blending tool, white cardstock, sequins and wired ribbon.

Instructions:-

1. Measure a piece of cardstock to fit the front of a notebook to alter. Add layers of stenciling to the cardstock panel. Set aside.



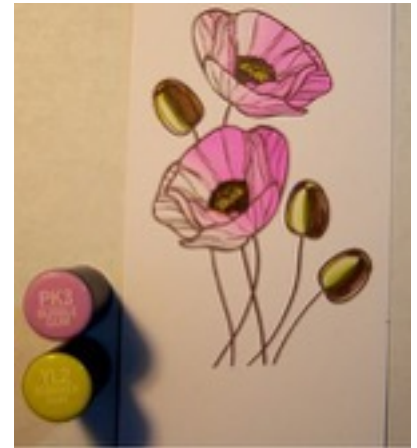
2. Stamp a coordinating image onto cardstock. Using Olive Green (OL3) and the brush nib and infuse for 5 seconds and color about half the buds. Use Bark (BR5) and the brush nib infusing for 5 seconds and color the other half of the bud overlapping in the middle.

- Using Bubble Gum (PK3) and the brush nib infuse for 5-10 seconds and color the flowers in sections making the left side of the flowers lighter. Use pure color in Summer Sun (YL2) and the brush nib to color in the flower centres.



- Trim out the stamped and colored image. Adhere the stencilled panel to the notebook. Adhere the colored image to stencilled panel using foam adhesive for added dimension.
- Embellish with sequins and ribbon.
