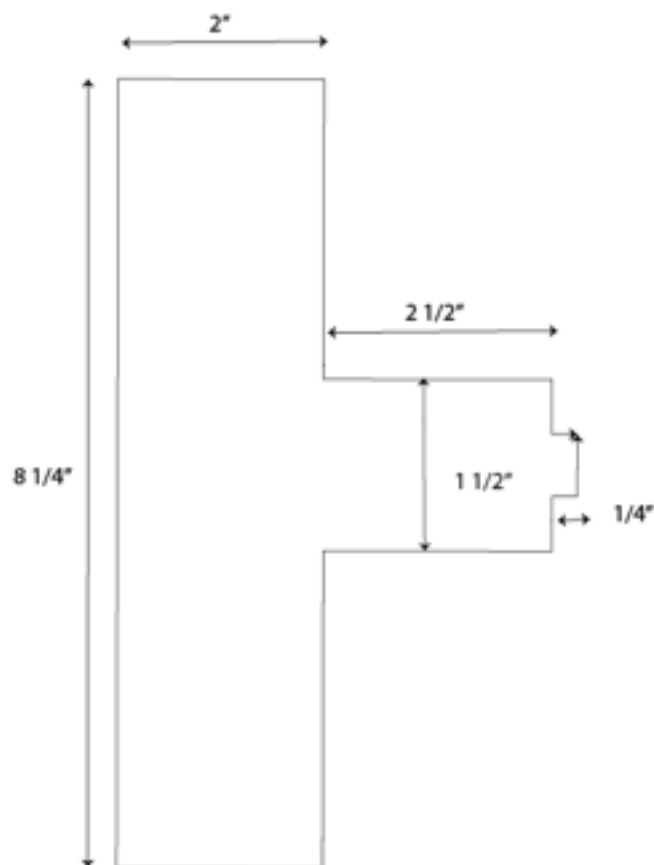




Materials used:- Chameleon Color Tones Pens 52 pen set, Fuchsia (PK5), Deep Violet (VO4), Tangerine (OR3), The Crafters Workshop Mini Daisy Splash Stencil, Imagine Crafts Shimmer Creative Medium, Acetate, painters tape, hot glue.

1) Cut out tea light template as per image and dimensions shown.

- 2) Attach Stencil to acetate with tape and apply Creative Medium with palette knife. Allow to dry. (It will turn clear when dry).



- 3) Take the Fuchsia pen and fuse the brush nib for 3 seconds then color the individual petals on top of the paste, re-infuse the nib in-between coloring each petal.



- 4) Repeat the process using other colors until all petals are colored.



- 5) Curl acetate to form tea light holder shape and glue into place to finish.
