

## Best Wishes Card by Leah Cornelius



Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set and Floral Tones set; Aqua Marine (BG4), Fuchia (PK5), Spring Meadow (YG3), Bubble Gum (PK3), Summer Sun (YL2), Grass Green (GR3), Bark (BR5), DCWV Color and Create Floral stack, DCWV Gold Threaded Burlap paper, DCWV Mixed Media cardstock stack, Tim Holtz Tattered Florals die, Inspired By Stamping Fancy Labels 3 die, pearls.

### Instructions:

- i. Begin by selecting a card from the Color and Create Floral pack. Trim out the desired sentiment. Die cut a mat for the sentiment. Die cut two flowers out of the burlap paper. Set aside.

2. Begin coloring all the leaves using Spring Meadow (YG3) and Grass Green (GR3). Use the brush nib and infuse for 5-8 seconds per leaf alternating the greens.





3. Color the flowers using several colors; Fuchsia (PK5), Bubble Gum (PK3), Aqua Marine (BG4) and Summer Sun (YL2). For the berries use Bark (BR5). Use the brush nib and infuse for a variety of times depending on the size of the flower. Infuse for 8-10 seconds for large flowers and 5 seconds for small flowers. Use pure color for the very small details.



4. Adhere the burlap flowers and sentiment to the card. Embellish with pearls.
