

Happy Day Project by Leah Cornelius



Materials Used: Chameleon Tones Deluxe Set and Floral Tones; Olive Green (OL3), Spring Meadow (YG3), Peony Pink (PK4), Dusty Rose (PK2), Aqua Marine (BG4), Summer Sun (YL2); Altenew Botanical Garden, Altenew Henna Elements, My Favorite Things Blueprints #20, Tuexdo Black ink, MISTI stamping tool, Papertrey Ink Bitty Dot paper, Recollections cardstock, sequins.

Instructions:

1. Die cut the layers for the card. Stamp the rose and butterfly onto the white cardstock panel. Stamp the rose onto a post it note to create a mask. Stamp the butterfly again onto another piece of white cardstock.

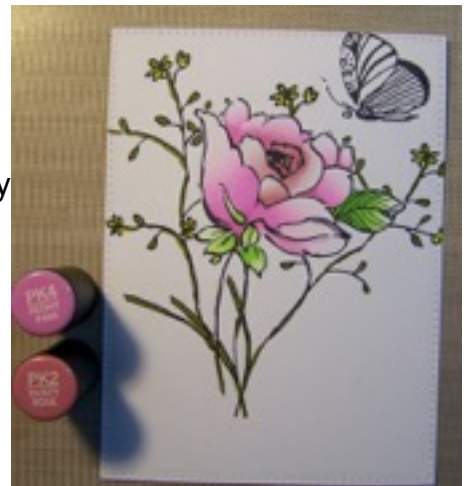
2. Trim out the mask and stamp the background flowers.



3. Begin coloring the background flower leaves using Olive Green (OL3) using the brush nib and pure color. Color the small flowers using Summer Sun (YL2) and the brush nib and pure color.



4. Begin coloring the rose's leaves using Spring Meadow (YG3) and the brush nib infusing for 5 seconds. Using Peony Pink (PK4) and the brush nib infuse for 5-10 seconds and color the outside petals of the rose. Continue coloring the rose's inner petals using Dusty Rose (PK2) and the brush nib infusing for 5 seconds.

5. Using Aqua Marine (BG4) and the brush nib for 3 seconds and color part of the butterfly's wing. Color the second butterfly in the same manner. Using Summer Sun (YL2) and the brush nib infuse for 5 seconds and color of the butterfly's wing. Repeat for the second butterfly. Trim out the second butterfly.



6. Stamp the sentiment onto the the die cut strip. Assemble the card layers. Gently bend the lower body part of the trimmed out butterfly and apply adhesive only to that spot and Embellish with a row of sequins.
