

Roses and Butterfly Card by Leah Cornelius



Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set and Floral Tones; Spring Green (YG3) Olive Green (OL3), Peony Pink (PK4), Dusty Rose (PK2), Summer Sun (YL2), Heartfelt Creations Botanical Rose Bouquet stamp set, Heartfelt Creations Botanical Wings die set, Memento Tuxedo Black ink, White and Turquoise cardstock, My Favorite Things Natural Twine, Sequins, Sewing Machine.

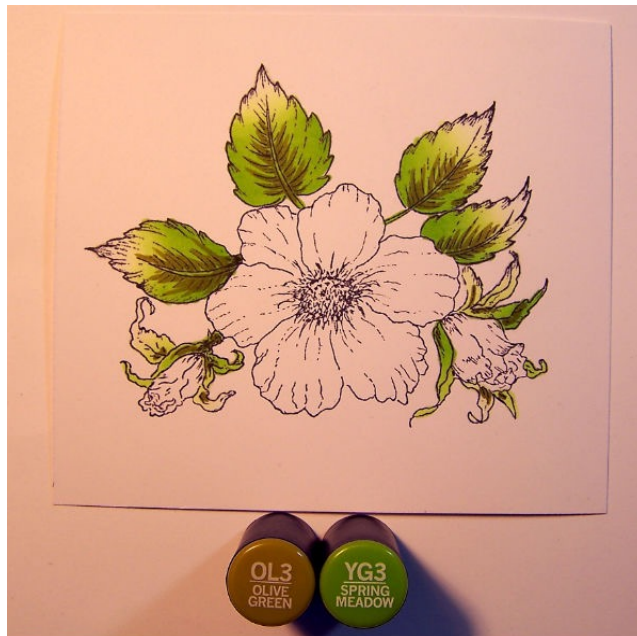

Instructions:

- i. Cut a card panel and stamp the rose image all over it in black ink. Cut another panel of white cardstock and stamp the rose image once. Set aside the card base panel.



2. Begin coloring the individual rose image by using Spring Meadow (YG3) and the brush nib infusing for 10 seconds and color the leaves starting from the tips and working down. Use Olive Green (OL3) and the brush nib and with a flicking motion add pure color along the center veins of the leaves.

3. Color the roses using the brush nib and Peony Pink (PK4) and infusing for 10-15 seconds per petal. Using Dusty Rose (PK2) and a flicking motion add pure color along the lines of the veins in the petals. Using Summer Sun (YL2) and the brush nib use pure color for the rose center.



4. Die cut a butterfly out of solid colored cardstock. Sew the two card layers together and assemble. Embellish with sequins and twine.
