



Materials required:-

Chameleon Color Tone Pens; Green Apple (GR1) and Lavender (BV2), Penny Black stamps Winter Wonders 30-087 (sentiment 'Just for you') and Winter Joy (Poinsettia), Penny Black Die Gift Card Pocket 51-191, Memento Grape Jelly and Lulu Lavender ink pads and Grape Jelly and Bamboo Leaves Memento Dual Tip Brush Markers. White and Lavender card stock, glue and foam pads.

Instructions:-

- Die cut gift holder from Lavender card and sentiment panel from white card.



- Stamp sentiment onto panel using Memento Grape Jelly ink.

Tip:- I like to use a MISTI stamp positioner that way if the sentiment doesn't stamp out fully first time, you can re-ink and re-stamp.



- Stamp the poinsettia onto white card (we recommend you use a card designed for alcohol markers), using Memento Lulu Lavender ink. We have used a MISTI to ensure that the image stamps in the same place for the next step, alternatively you can use a stamp positioner.



Poinsettia Gift Card Holder

- Then ink up the areas you want as leaves and the centre of the flower with the Bamboo Leaves dual tip pen and then color the remaining veins in the petals using the Purple Grape dual tip pen (don't color the petal edges with this color).



- Fuse the brush nib of the Green Apple pen for a count of 6 and then color from the tip to the centre of the leaf, fuse the pen again and repeat for the remaining leaves.



- Fuse the brush nib of the Green Apple pen again and color the larger petals from the outside edge towards the centre, repeat the process until all the large leaves are colored. Then fuse the brush nib of the Lavender pen for a count of 8 and color the larger leaves from the centre out towards the outside edge of the petal, repeat for all the large petals.



- Fuse the brush nib of the Lavender pen for a count of 5 and then color from the outer tip towards the centre of the smaller petals. Then fuse the bullet nib of the Green Apple pen for 5 seconds and color the centre of the flower, color off back to the original shade and then add dark shadows.



- Fussy cut around the flower and into the centre of each petal, then shape alternate petals up from the centre and add foam pads. Assemble all elements to make the gift card.
