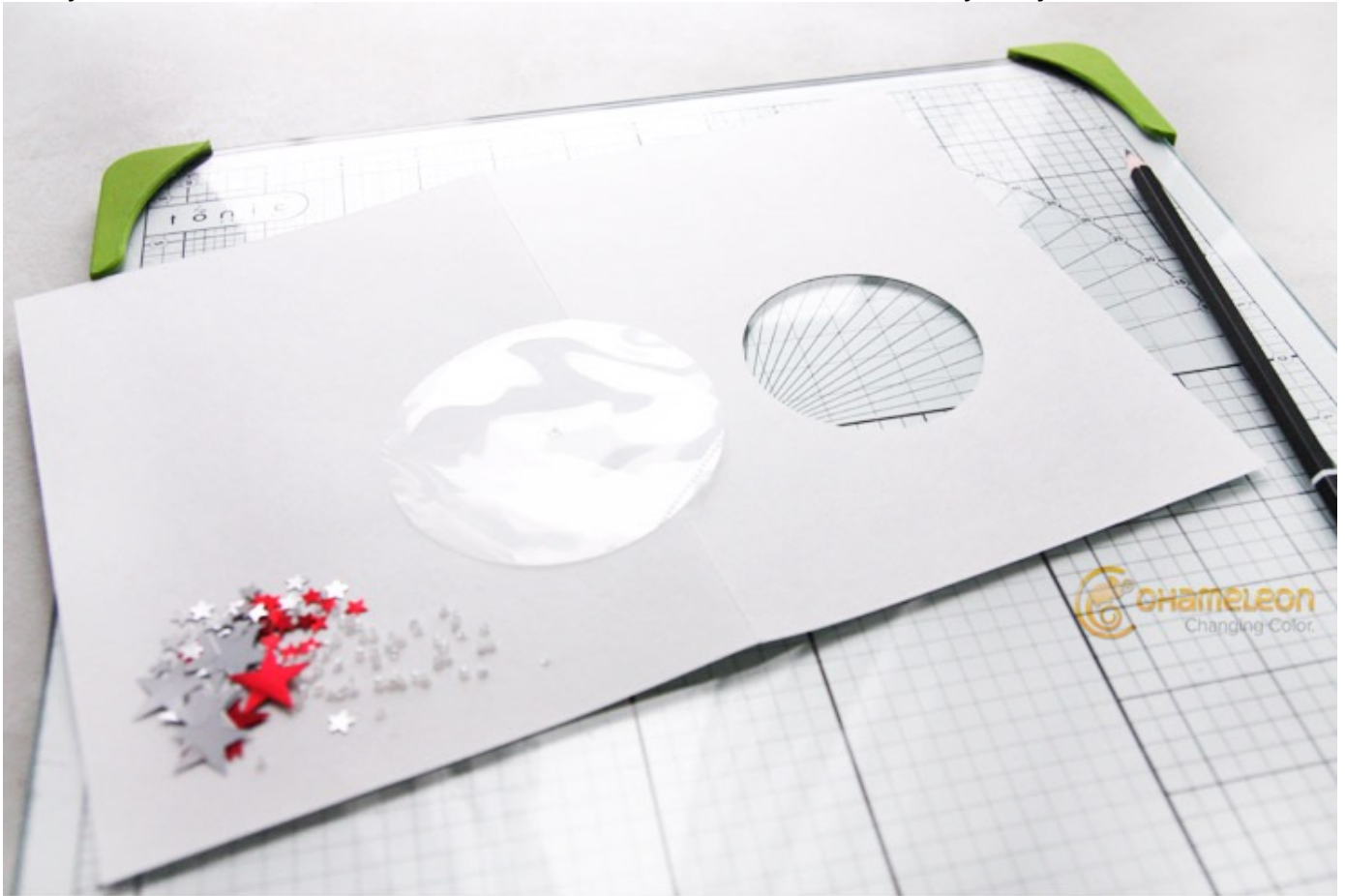




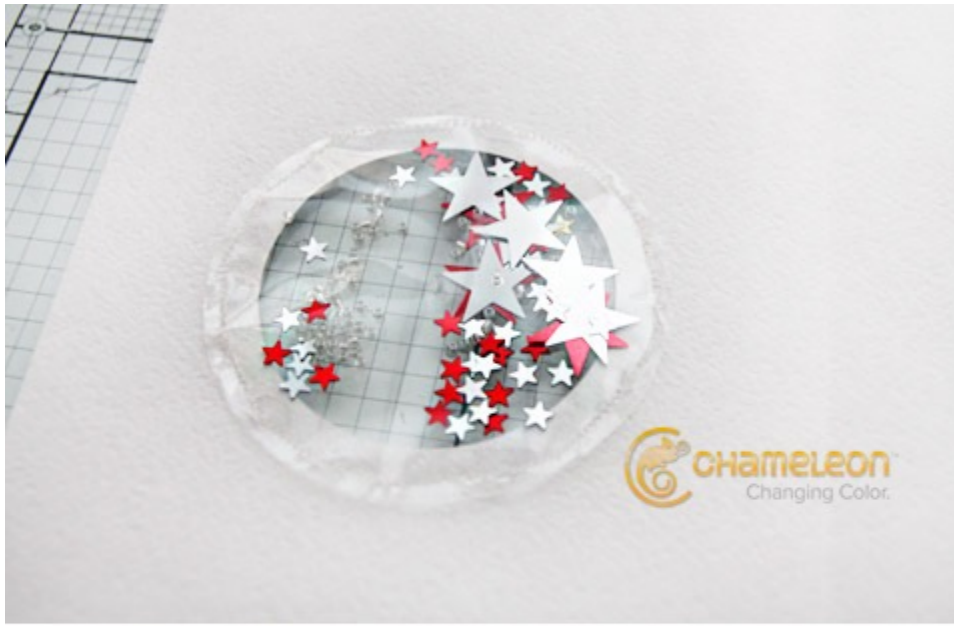
Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Bark (BR5); Crimson Red (RD4); Olive Green (OL3); Hero Arts Vintage Christmas Post clear stamps set, watercolor paper, sequins and beads.

Instructions:

1. Fold A4 watercolor sheet of paper in half to make a card base. Cut a circle 6,5 cm (2,5') in diameter on the front side of the card. Cut two circles 7,5 cm (3') in diameter from plastic sheet. I used page protector. Seal two plastic circles with fuse tool or sew them together to make a circle pocket. Fill it with sequins and beads. Seal it.



2. Adhere the plastic pocket inside the card base. Stamp the sentiment on a piece of paper and place inside the circle.



- Using the circle mask, stamp the branches and the cones round the circle hole.



- Stamp the images of the bird, mistletoe and poinsettia several times. Color the bird with Crimson Red and Bark without infusing the color.



5. Color four poinsettias with Crimson Red using the bullet tip infusing the color before coloring for 1 second. Color the mistletoe with Olive Green using the bullet tip infusing the color before coloring for 3 seconds. Cut the images out.



6. Adhere the mistletoes and poinsettias around the circle. Place the bird on the wreath.
