

Merry and Bright by Leah Cornelius



Materials Used: Chameleon Pens Deluxe Color Tones, Fawn (NU3), Cool Gray (CG8), Bark (BR5), Olive Green (OL3), Crimson Red (RD4), Hero Arts Winter Fun stamp set, Spellbinders die, Papertrey Ink Bitty Dot Paper, Memento Tuxedo Black ink, Versamark ink, Zing! Embossing powder in Silver Glitter, Ranger Heat It Tool, MISTI stamping tool.

Instructions:

- i. Cut card layers and die cut focal image panel. Stamp the tree, sentiment and snowflakes onto the die cut panel. Emboss the falling snow with silver glitter embossing powder and heat set. Stamp the other images onto another piece of cardstock.



2. Begin by coloring the tree using Olive Green (OL2) and the brush nib infusing for 5 seconds. Color from the outside in so the tree tips are lighter.



3. Color the other images using a variety of colors, Crimson Red (RD4), Bark (BR5), Cool Gray (CG8) and Fawn (NU3). Use the brush nib and infuse for 5 seconds for the blends. Trim out.

4. Assemble the card and arrange all the animals and presents around the tree. Embellish with sequins and a bow.
