

Easter Bag by Leah Cornelius



Materials Used: Chameleon Pens Deluxe set and Floral Tones; Cool Gray (CG8), Peony Pink (PK4), Fuchsia (PK5), Seville Orange (OR4), Spring Meadow (YG3), Summer Sun (YL2), Aqua Marine (BG4), My Favorite Things Somebunny stamp set, Memento Tuxedo Black ink, White paper lunch bag, Papertrey Ink Tag Sale #10 die, seam binding ribbon, fabric flower.

Instructions:

- i. Trim down a white paper bag and punch two holes an inch apart to string ribbon through. Cut a piece of pink seam binding ribbon and die

cut the tag pieces. Set aside. Randomly stamp the carrot image onto the paper bag. Stamp the bunny, sentiment, extra flowers and bow onto white cardstock.



2. Begin by coloring the fabric flowers using Summer Sun (YL2) and the brush nib infusing for 6 seconds. Use short quick strokes to add light color from the center outward. Using Seville Orange (OR4) and the brush nib infuse for 5 seconds and color the carrots on the paper bag. Use Spring Meadow (YG3) and the brush nib infusing for 5 seconds to color the tops of the carrots. Set the bag aside.



3. Color the extra flowers and bow using Aqua Marine (BG4), Summer Sun (YL2), and Peony Pink (PK4) using the brush nib and infusing for 3-5 seconds per image. Trim them out. Color the bunny using Cool Gray (CG8)

and the brush nib infusing for 8 seconds. Color the clothes using Peony Pink (PK4), Fuchsia (PK5) and Aqua Marine (BG4) and the brush nib using pure color.



4. Assemble the tag pieces and adhere to bag. Tie ribbon through the holes in the bag and attach the flower. Embellish with a button.
