

Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Aqua Marine (BG4); Warm Sunset (YO3); Fabrika Decoru gold embossing powder; Fabrika Decoru liquid enamel dots (yellow); Altenew Beautiful Day clear stamps; DCWV Embossed White embossed paper; vellum.

1. Stamp a flower with the embossing ink on a piece of vellum, sprinkle it with gold embossing powder, and heat with the heat tool. Stamp the same flower with the black ink on a scrap piece of paper and cut the image. Use the cut image as a mask to cover the gold embossed flower before stamping the second flower. Use this mask technique to stamp the flower branches.



2. Stamp the same flower with the black archival ink on a scrap piece of paper. Color the flower with the brush tip using Warm Sunset infusing each color before coloring for 3 seconds.



3. Flip the piece of vellum with the embossed images and color the flowers with the brush tip using Aqua Marine infusing each color before coloring for 2 seconds. Let it dry. Flip the vellum again and adhere the colored flower using the foam double-sided tape.



4. Add sentiment and some drops with liquid enamel.
