



Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tone Pens Peony Pink (PK4) and Green Apple (GR1), Memento Luxe Tuxedo Black Ink, Hobbycraft Cotton Zipped bag, Aloe Vera gel, Penny Black Demure Cling stamp 40-375.

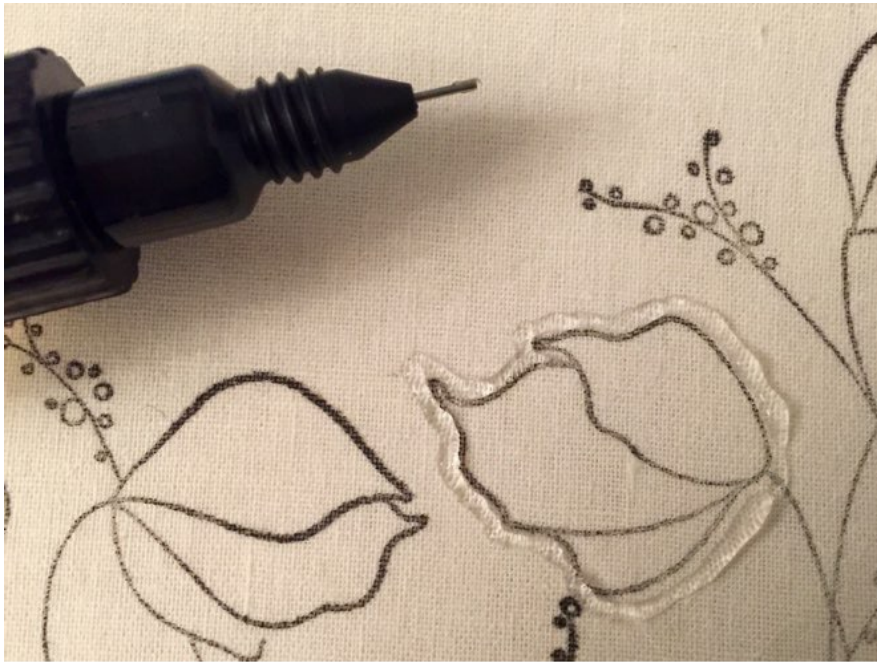
Additional Tools: Iron, Imagine Crafts Multi Purpose Squeegee, cardboard and Empty Pico Embellisher bottle.

Instructions:

1. Place cardboard inside bag (this will prevent ink from seeping through to the other side). Stamp image onto washed cotton bag using Memento Luxe ink and then heat set with an iron.



2. Fill the Pico Embellisher bottle with Aloe Vera gel and pipe around the flower bud.



3. Fuse the bullet nib of the Peony Pink pen for 10 seconds and color the smaller petal, fuse again for 15 seconds and color the larger petals.



4. Once all the petals are colored scrape off the excess Aloe Vera Gel and wipe on a tissue. Repeat steps 2-4 until all the petals are colored.
5. Use the Green Apple bullet nib without fusing and dot quickly on the leaf stem buds.



6. Leave to dry overnight, to ensure fully dry go over the project with an iron before washing in cold water.
