

Hugs and Kisses Card by Leah Cornelius



Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set and Floral Tones in Spring Meadow (YG3), Fuchsia (PK5), Crimson Red (RD4), Cool Gray (CG8), Altenew Botanical Garden stamp set, Wplus9 Valentine Wishes stamp set, Papertrey Ink Shakers and Sprinkles heart die, Memento Tuxedo Black Ink, Prima Patterned paper Royal Menagerie, sequins, sewing machine, white cardstock.

Instructions:

- i. Cut a panel of white cardstock and a same size panel in patterned paper. Die cut a heart out of the center of the patterned paper. Stamp the image and sentiment.



2. Begin coloring the stem on the rose using Spring Green (YG3) and the brush nib, infusing for 6 seconds.

3. Color the rose bud using Fuchsia (PK5) and the brush nib, infusing for 15 seconds. Along the vein lines in the flower add pure color using crimson Red (RD4) and the brush nib. Use flicking motions in an upward manner.



4. Using Cool Gray (CG8) and the brush nib for 5 second intervals add a drop shadow to the left side of the image. Use some pure color right up against the outline of the flower.



5. Assemble card. Add machine stitching and embellish with sequins.
