

Rhododendron Card by Leah Cornelius



Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tone Deluxe set; Spring Green (YG3), Olive Green (OL3), Sky Blue (BL3), Blue Violet (BV4), Mauve (VO2), Detail Pen (D), Technique Tuesday Rhododendron stamp set, Papertrey Ink border die, Prima patterned paper Royal Menagerie, Memento Tuxedo Black ink, cream cardstock, MISTI.

Instructions:

- i. Stamp the image and sentiment onto cream cardstock. Die cut border and set aside.

2. Begin coloring the leaves using Spring Meadow (YG3) using the brush nib and infusing for 10 seconds. Go back to the dark part of the leaves using Olive Green (OL3) and the brush nib infusing for 5 seconds. Concentrate the color on the parts of the leaves where the stamp image indicates shadows.



3. Begin coloring the flowers using Sky Blue (BL3) and Blue Violet (BV4) and Mauve (VO2) alternating between colors. Use the brush nib for each and infuse for varying time per petal and color; anywhere from 5-10

seconds blending the colors into each other. Use some pure color in the shadowed areas indicated on the stamped image.



4. Adhere the border to the card front and embellish with sequins and faux stitching using the Detail Pen (D).
