

What If You Fly Card by Leah Cornelius



Materials Used: Chameleon Tones Deluxe set; Sky Blue (BL3), Summer Sun (YL2), Bark (BR5), Grass Green (GR3), Detail Pen (D), Inspired By Stamping Summer Warbler stamp set, Memento Tuxedo Black ink, Avery Elle Finished Frames dies, sewing machine, silk flowers, buttons.

Instructions:

- i. Cut a piece of white cardstock to 3 ¼" x 4 ¼". Stamp the image and sentiment onto it. Begin coloring the bird using Sky Blue (BL3) and the brush nib infusing for 5-8 second intervals. Color about half the bird.



2. Using Summer Sun (YL2) and the brush nib infuse for 10 seconds and color the bottom of the bird. Go back over the bird using Sky Blue (BL3) and the brush nib using short strokes to give some texture of feathers. Alternate with Summer Sun (YL2) and the brush nib, blending the two colors together using short strokes. Use Seville Orange (OR4) and pure color with the brush nib to color the beak and add some short strokes into

the wing. Use Bark (BR5) to color the branch using pure color and the brush nib.



3. Using the Detail Pen (D) draw in some simple leaf shapes and veins.



4. Color the leaves using Grass Green (GR3) and the brush nib infusing for 5-8 seconds.

5. Assemble the card. Embellish with a flower, stitching and buttons.
