



Materials required:

Chameleon Color Tone Pens Light Peach, Green Apple and Mellow Yellow. Chameleon Colour Tops Warm Sunset, Peony Pink and Dark Sage, Chameleon Colour Tone Pencils 9 01/01 Warm Pink/Lychee & 20 01/02 Cactus Green/Summer Leaf. AlteNew Peony Scrolls, Beautiful Day, Remember This and Wood Pallet Background stamps, Memento inks Angel Pink, Dandelion and New Sprout. Versafine Onyx Black ink, Frayed Burlap Distress ink. X-Press It, Light Grey, Pink and Brown Cardstock, Acetate, Glue, Sequins, Nesting Rectangle and Decal Edge dies.

Tools:- Misti stamping tool, water brush, die cutting machine, post it notes, scissors.

How to:

- 1) Stamp two flowers from the Peony Scrolls set with Angel Pink ink and then mask off with post it notes, then stamp the flowers with Dandelion and leaves using New Sprout from the Remember this set.



2) Take the Light Peach pen and fuse the brush nib of the pen with the Peony Pink Color Top for 6 seconds for the larger petals and color in individually re-infusing with the color top between each petal, fuse for only 3 seconds for the smaller petals. *Tip: Work in small circles to get a smooth even blend.*



3) Using the brush nib of the Green Apple pen fuse with the Dark Sage color top for 1 second and then add veins and shadow to the leaves then as the color lightens colour out the rest of the leaf. Repeat until all the leaves are colored.



4) Fuse the bullet nib of the mellow yellow pen for one second and then add the dark shading for the smaller flowers and then color the rest of the flower to give the variation in tone. Repeat until all the small flowers are colored.

5) Take the Warm Pink end of the Chameleon Color tone pencil and add detail to the base of the flower petals, then flip the pencil over and add further detail using the Lychee color to the tips of the petals.



6) Use the Cactus Green pencil to add additional depth to the leaf shape and the Summer Leaf to define the leaf veins.



7) Fussy cut around the design.



8) Stamp the Wood Pallet Background onto light grey card using Frayed Burlap Distress ink and then using some of the ink tapped onto the acrylic from the MISTI, color in the individual wood panels.

9) Stamp the sentiment from the Beautiful Day set onto white card using Versafine ink and mount onto pink card. Then Assemble all the elements to create the card design and add sequins to finish.
