



Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Chameleon Color Tones 30 Pens Set; Nude (NU00); Sand (NU0); Caramel (NU4); Bubble Gum (PK3); Mauve (VO2); Purple Grape (PR4); Ranger Glossy Accents Mini; quilling paper.

Instructions:

1. Start with making palette that matches the colors on photo. Cut the circle frame and other corresponding shapes using Silhouette Cameo.



2. Color the bear on the frame with the Caramel without infusing the color. After that, color another bear with the Nude also without infusing the color. Add some shading with the Sand to the separate bear and mount it on the bear in the circle frame using the foam double tape.



3. Color the bow, the heart and the handle in the circle frame with the Mauve. Color the separate bow with the Bubble Gum. Add some shading on the bow using the Mauve and the Purple Grape. Adhere the colored bow on the bow in the circle using the foam double adhesive.



4. Color the pacifier in the circle with the Caramel. After that color the parts of the pacifier starting with the Nude and Sand, and finishing with the Caramel.



5. Adhere the frame with the colored pieces and the photo on the patterned paper. Color the letters and adhere them too. Add some shiny accents here and there with the Ranger Glossy Accents.



- Using the liquid adhesive start to add the paper stripes for quilling to add some dimension to the project .
