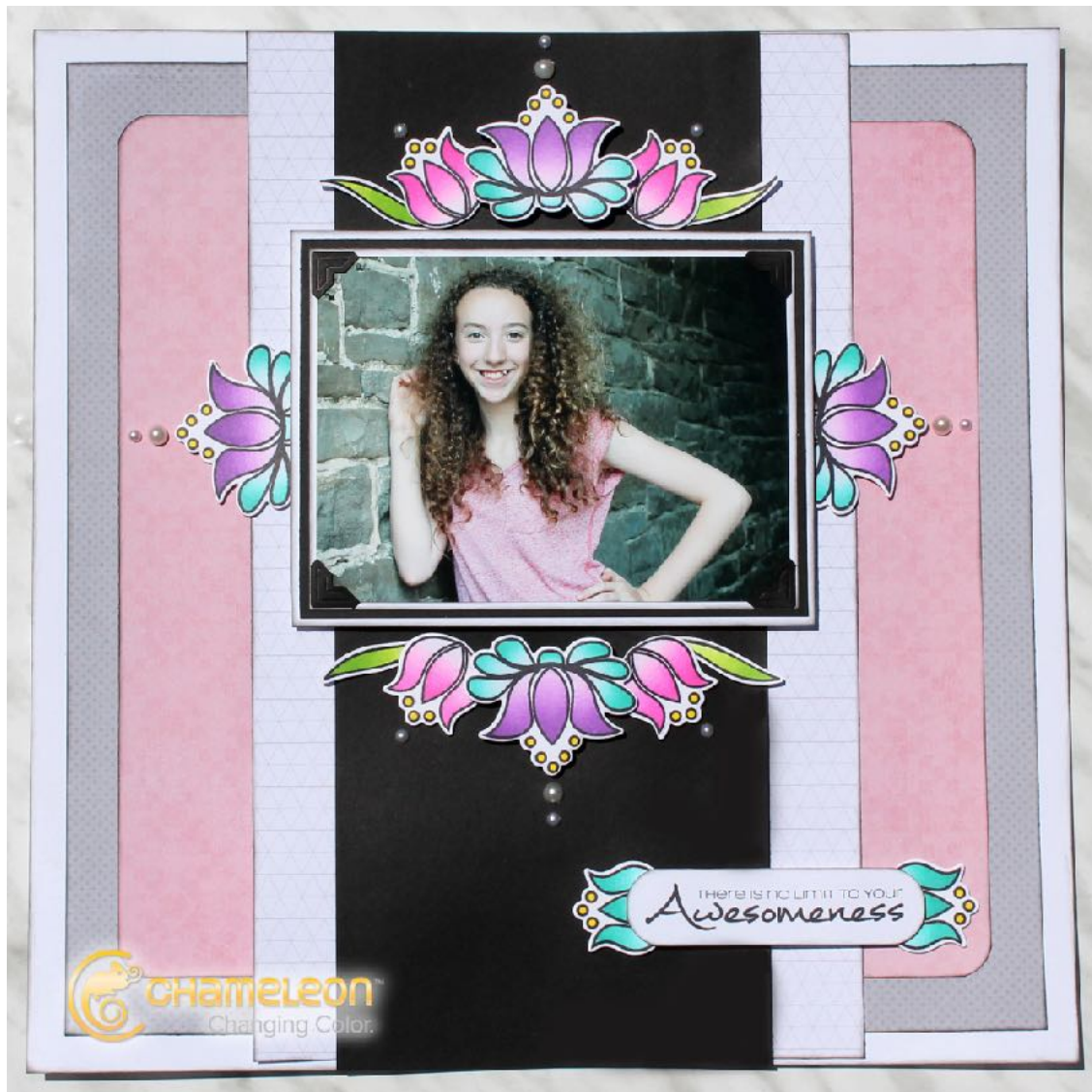


Cas-ual Friday and Chameleon Layout by Tracy McLennon



Materials Used:

Chameleon Pens; Fuchsia (PK5), Aqua Marine (BG4), Summer Sun (YL2), Spring Meadow (YG3), Purple Grape (PR4); Cas-ual Friday- Mon Ami Cling Stamps and Dies; White and Black Cardstock; Ranger Archival Ink- Jet Black; Heidi Swapp- September Skies Patterned Paper; Pearls; Scrapbook Adhesives by 3L; Thin 3D Foam Squares, 3D Foam Squares, Black Photo Corners, Extreme Double Sided Tape, E-Z Runner Grand

How to:-

1) Stamp the flowers and leaves onto white card using Ranger Archival ink. For all of the larger petals and leaves use a 5 second fuse for each pen color choice. For the smaller Aqua Marine petals, use a 3 second fuse. Do not fuse the pen when coloring the dots above each of the flowers.



2) Construct the layered background as follows: -

- ◆ White cardstock 12x12
- ◆ Grey patterned paper 11.5x11.5
- ◆ Pink patterned paper 10.75x10.75 (round the corners)
- ◆ White patterned paper 6.5x12
- ◆ Black cardstock 5x12

3) Matt the photo in white, black and then white cardstock. add black photo corners to the photo. Then adhere the matted photo to my layered background using 3D foam squares.

4) Begin to add flowers and leaves around the matted photo. Use different thicknesses of 3D foam to add layers of dimension between the flowers and leaves. Then add the different sized pearls.

5) Stamp the sentiment on a separate piece of white cardstock and round the corners. Adhere to the bottom right hand corner of the layout using 3D foam, along with the aqua marine flowers.
