## "Watercolour" Wedding Layout by Tracy McLennon




## **Materials Used:**

Chameleon Pens; Fuchsia (PK5), Evergreen (GR4), Spring Meadow (YG3), Peony Pink (PK4), Tangerine (OR3), Summer Sun (YL2), Red Coral (RD3); Ranger Archival Ink- Jet Black; Heidi Swapp Paper- September Skies; Pearls; Scrapbook Adhesives by 3L; 3D Foam Squares, E-Z Runner Grand, Black Creative Photo Corners; Close To My Heart Cling Stamps-; White and Black Cardstock; Tag; Burlap String; Rubbing Alcohal; Water Brush; Acrylic Block; Stickles- Yellow;



1) Take an extra water brush and fill it with rubbing alcohol. It tends to flow a little faster through the brush, so a little practice is always best. Take an acrylic block and colour swatches on it using your chosen Chameleon pen colours. Take the "alcohol brush" and pick up some colour and wash it onto white cardstock. The colour will move for a limited time when working, blending out to a nice watercolour look.



2) Cut white cardstock to 11x11. Using Ranger Archival Ink, stamp images on the background cardstock. This will take a little pre planning. Heat set the ink before adding colour.



3) Using the brush pen and PK4 (Peony Pink), add colour to the edge of the large heart. Using the brush pen and GR4 (Evergreen), add colour to the tips of all of the leaves. Add the RD2 (Red Coral), OR3 (Orange Seville) and YL2 (Summer Sun) to flower middles and the berries without fusing. Add PK5 (Fuchsia) to some of the flower petals with a 3 second fuse. Add PK4 (Peony Pink) to the rest of the flower petals with a 4 second fuse. Add YG3 (Spring Meadow) to the inner part of the larger leaves with a 3 second fuse.



- 4) Grey patterned paper- 12x12
  Black cardstock- 11.25x11.25
  Pink patterned paper- 2x9 (flagged at the bottom)
- 5) Mat the photo in white cardstock, black cardstock and grey patterned paper. Add black photo corners to the photo. Adhere to the layout using 3D foam squares.





5) Add pearls here and there for a little shine. Add yellow Stickles to the middles of all of the flowers. Add the black tag to the left hand side of the matted photo and add a bow of burlap string.
