

Halloween Layout by Tracy McLennon



Materials Used:

Chameleon Pens; Purple Grape (PR4), Detail Pen, Evergreen (GR4), Spring Meadow (YG3), Tangerine (OR3), Summer Sun (YL2), Deep Black (BK4); Core'dinations Patterned Paper; Black and White Cardstock; Thickers Letter Stickers; Scrapbook Adhesives by 3L; Black Creative Photo Corners, 3D Foam Squares, E-Z Runner Grand

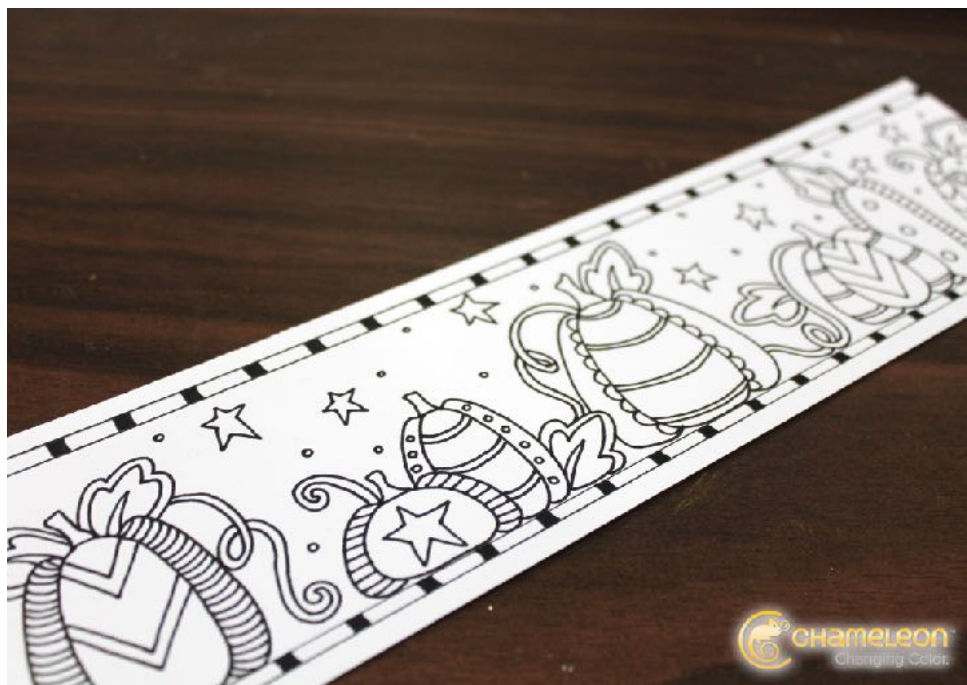
How To:-

- 1) When there just is NOT the right stamp set to create with, then create one. Cut white cardstock

to 2.5x12. Draw pencil lines down the length of the cardstock to create borders on top and bottom and to use as a guide for drawing.



- 2) Begin doodling, and continue the full length of the border. Come back and add detail to each image.



3) Come back and create the borders on top and bottom of the piece of doodled cardstock.



4) Begin adding the colour. Start with Spring Meadow, Evergreen and Tangerine. Some of the smaller images are not fused. But for the slightly larger spaces, use a 4 second fuse.



5) Add the next 3 colours; Deep Black, Purple Grape and Summer Sun. Do not fuse those itty bitty spaces. But for the larger spaces use a 4 second fuse.



Layered Background:

- Black Cardstock- 12x12
- Orange Stripe- 11x12
- Yellow Plaid- 10x12
- Green Polka Dot- 8x7
- White Doodled Cardstock- 2.5x12
- Purple Polka Dot- 3x12
- Purple Polka Dot Banner- 1.25x10



6) Mat photo in white and black cardstock. Add black photo corners to the photo. Adhere the matted photo to the layout using 3D foam squares. Add the title using letter stickers.
