



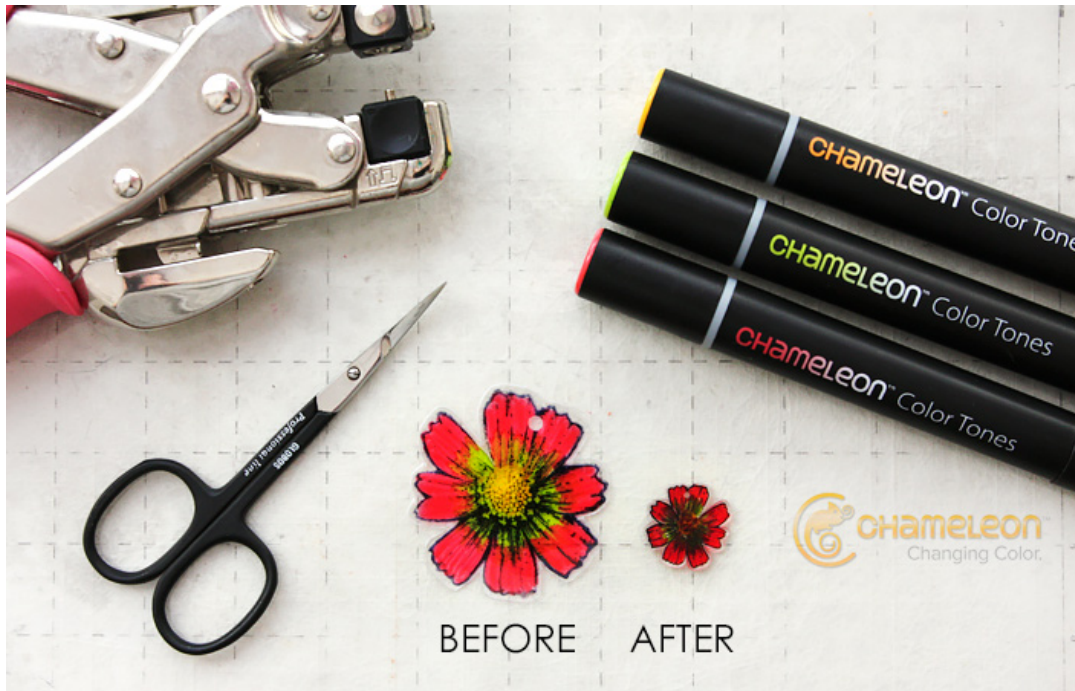
Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Spring Meadow (YG3); Warm Sunset (YO3); Crimson Red (RD4); Lesia Zgharda flower Stamp; shrink plastic; archival ink.

Instructions:

1. Stamp two flowers on a piece of shrink plastic. Let the ink dry.



2. Flip over the shrink plastic and color the flowers with the brush tip using Spring Meadow, Warm Sunset and Crimson Red. Let the images dry.
3. Using the fine point scissors cut the colored images out.
4. Use Crop-A-Dile tool or any other tool to punch a hole. Keep in mind that the hole will be much smaller after shrinking.
5. Using the craft heat tool and tweezers start to heat the flower. The heat will curl and shrink the flower. Within a minute the plastic will uncurl and lie flat.



6. Attach the shrink flower and a bead to an earwire.
