



# Christmas Joy with Jessica Sanders

An art journal page tutorial  
featuring  
Chameleon Pens



## Gather your supplies.

- Chameleon Pens:
  - Crimson Red (RD4)
  - Warm Sunset (YO3)
  - Grass Green (GR3)
  - Royal Blue (BL6)
  - Cool Gray (CG8)
  - Detail Pen (D)
  - Colorless Blender (CB)
- White Cardstock
- Art journal
- Gesso
- Distress Oxide Inks
- Clear glitter pen
- 'Joy' stamp

## Get started.

- Gesso your journal page. Let dry.
- Create a splatter background with Distress Oxide Inks.
- Use the Detail pen and a template to draw 2" and  $\frac{3}{4}$ " circles on white cardstock.

## Color.



### Christmas Ornaments- brush nib

- Colors: RD4, GR3, BL6, YO3
  - These are large spaces for coloring, so fuse each color 20-25 seconds. This will give you a longer blend time. Color in a circular motion, working from the highlight to dark areas. Cut out your ornaments, and glue/tape them on your journal page.
- Add shadows to your ornaments with CG8, fusing 10 seconds per shadow.
- Add sparkle to your ornaments with a clear glitter pen.





## Final touches- Detail Pen

- With your Detail pen, draw lines across the top of the page to create a ribbon-like shape.
- Continue drawing with your detail pen to add the strings and bows to your ornaments. Add more details, if you like!
- Stamp your sentiment.
