



Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Chameleon Color Tones 30 Pens Set; Warm Sunset (YO3); Caramel (NU4); Bark (BR5); Green Apple (GR1); Dark Sage (GR2); Cinnamon (BR3); Warm Gray 3 (WG3); Warm Gray 7 (WG7); Webster's Pages It's Christmas patterned paper by Alison Kreft.

Instructions:

1. Stamp an image or draw yourself. Start to color the letter Y imitating ginger cookie with Caramel using the brush nib. Add shades with Bark.
2. Color the edges of cookie icing with Warm Gray 3 using the brush nib.
3. Color the ornament with Cinnamon using the brush nib infusing the color before coloring for 3 seconds.
4. Add some strokes here and there with white gel pen.



5. Color the stocking with Green Apple using the brush nib. Add shading to the white areas with Warm Gray 3.

6. Add shading on the stocking with Dark Sage and on the ornament with Warm Gray 3. Draw a snowflake on the ornament and knitting pattern on the stocking with white gel pen.



- Trim the A4 sized piece of white cardstock. Cut out 9 long triangle from the patterned paper and adhere them on the white background. Layer transparent polaroid frame, picture and some patterned paper. Add mini cloth pins and a cord. Adhere star shaped sequins.
