



Snowy Day with Jessica Sanders

A winter birthday card tutorial
featuring
Chameleon Pens



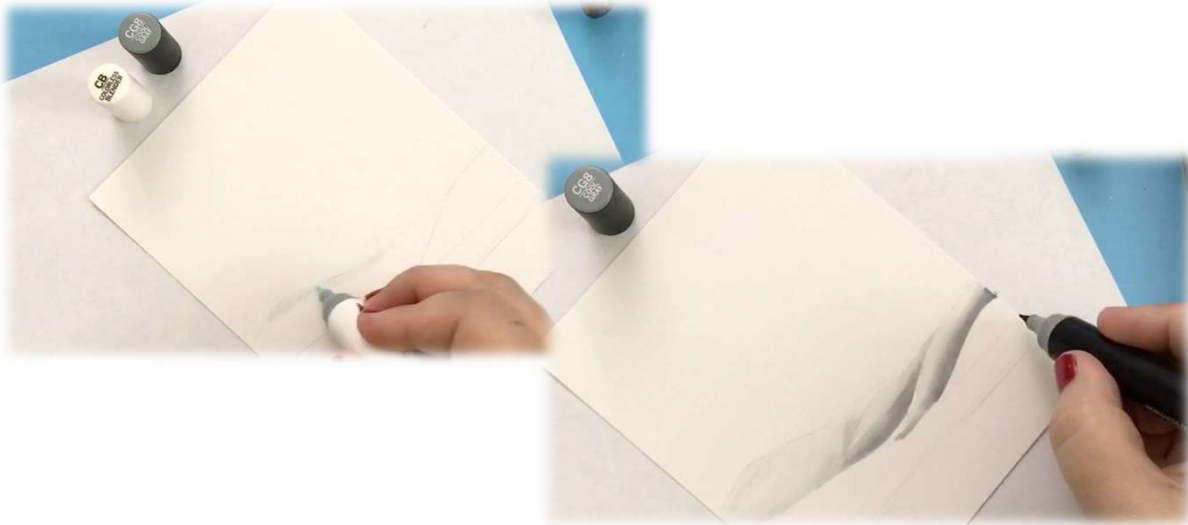
Gather your supplies.

- Chameleon Pens:
 - Lagoon (BG1)
 - Cool Gray (CG8)
 - Detail Pen (D)
 - Colorless Blender (CB)
- Pencil
- White Cardstock
- Colored cardstock
- Black ink stamp pad
- Mini tree and deer stamps

Get started.

- With a pencil, lightly draw contour shapes for mountains about 2/3 down from the top of your card.

Color.

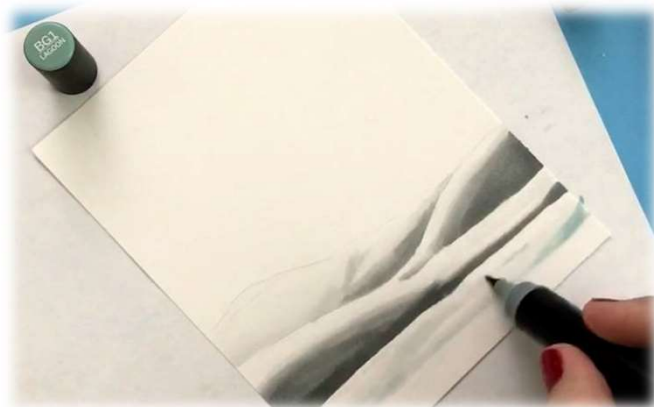


Mountains – brush nib

- With CB, add a layer of clear toner to the top of the mountain. This will create a wet layer for the color we are adding next to blend into.
- Fuse CG8 15 seconds, begin coloring into the area of the CB. Start with sweeping strokes to give contour to the mountains. As the ink begins to darken, use overlapping strokes to create a smooth blend. Repeat for the remaining mountains.

Snow – brush nib

- Draw random sweeping strokes with CB to create some shadow areas in the snow.
- Fuse BG1 10 seconds, and create overlapping sweeping strokes for deeper shadows. Work in some areas over the CB, as well.





Final touches– Detail Pen

- Stamp your trees and deer.
- Add small scribbles with the Detail pen to integrate your stamps.
- Stamp your sentiment.
- Assemble your card.
