

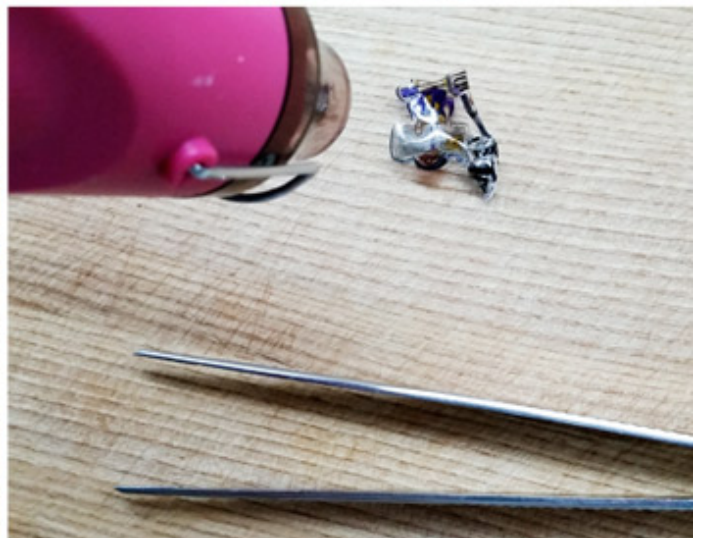
Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Warm Sunset (YO3); Crimson Red (RD4); Hot Cocoa (BR2); Deep Violet (VO4); Cool Grey (CG8); Lesia Zgharda clear stamp Reading Girl; shrink plastic; archival ink.

### Instructions:

1. Stamp a picture on a piece of shrink plastic. Let the ink dry. Flip over the shrink plastic and color the image with the bullet tip using Deep Violet, Warm Sunset, Hot Cocoa, Cool Grey and Crimson Red. Let the image dry. Using the fine point scissors cut the colored image out.



2. Now it's time for magic! Using the craft heat tool and the tweezers start to heat the image. The heat will curl and shrink it. Within a minute the plastic will uncurl and lie flat. Press it with something heavy for a second or two. I use the acrylic block for stamping.



3. The shrink plastic shrinks to really small thick objects! Remember this when you use it.



4. Adhere the shrunken image on a big paperclip.
