



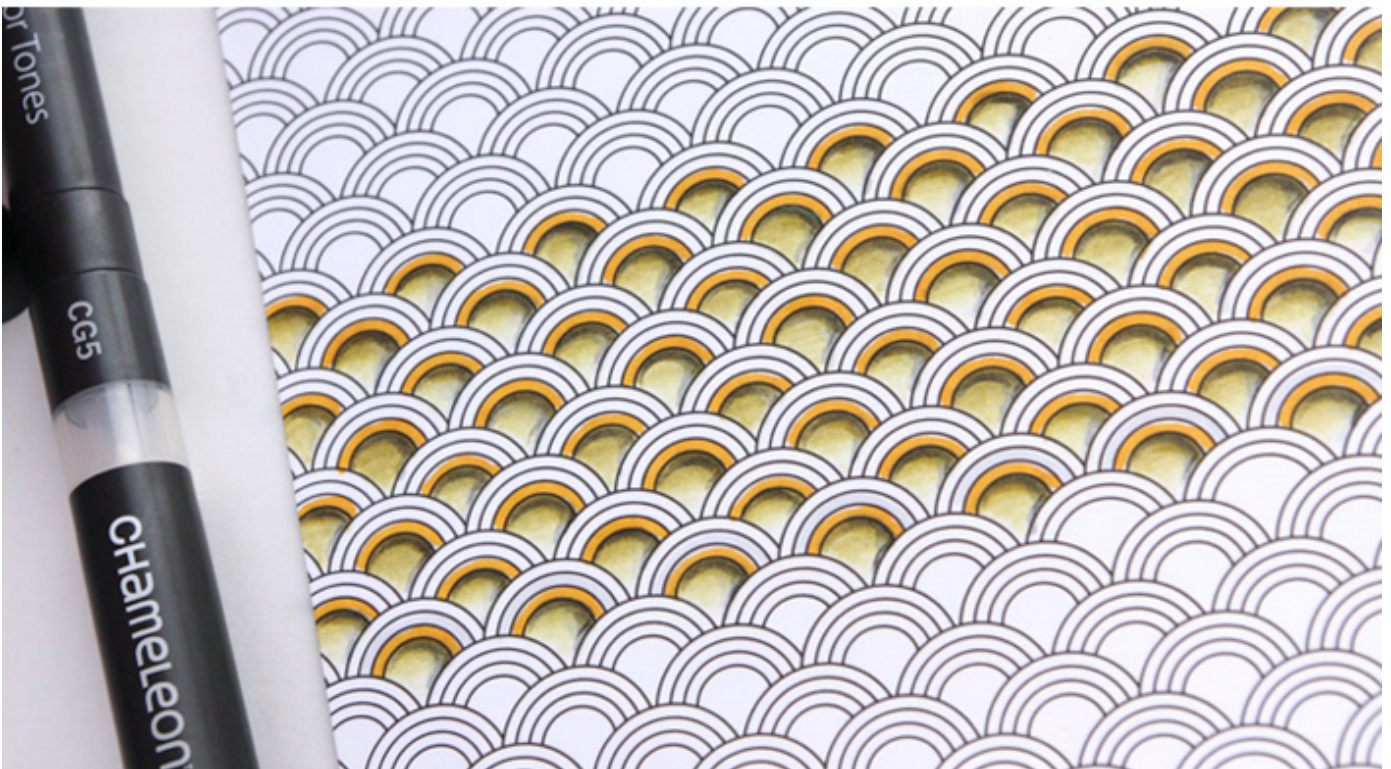
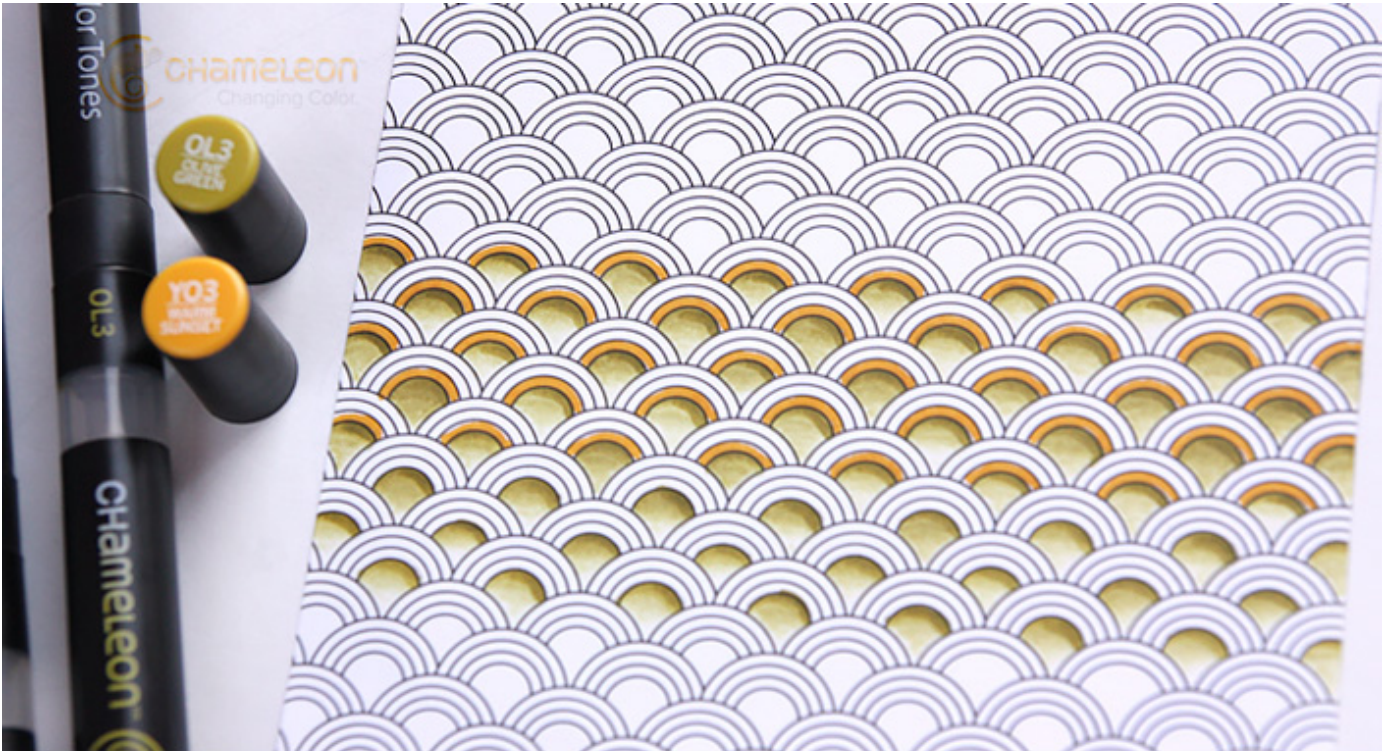
Materials Used: Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Chameleon Color Tones 30 Pens Set; Warm sunset (YO3); Olive Green (OL3); Cool Gray 5 (CG5); Rosy Dot heart Flowers dies; Rosy Owl leaf die; DCWV Color & Create Floral paper pad; colored foam sheets; Fabrica Dekoru enamel dots; doily.

Instructions:

1. Choose the patterned paper for the card background.



2. Color a part of the patterned paper using bullet nib with Olive Green infusing the color before coloring for 2 seconds. Add a stroke with Olive Green under every arch to make it look even more dimensional. Add more shading with the Cool Grey 5. Color the last stripe on every arch with Warm Sunset



3. Die cut flower petals using three different colors of foam. Place petals on a low temperature iron. Petal start to curl when ready. Use tweezers to remove from heat. Gently shape each petal by twisting edges and lightly pulling foam into desired shapes, working quickly before the petals cool off.
