

Chameleon/Maya Road by Tracy McLennon



Materials Used:

Chameleon Pens; Spring Meadow (YG3), Tangerine (OR3), Bisque (NU1), Deep Violet (VO4), Maya Road; Geometric Leaf Die, Kraft Large Ticket Strips, Ken Oliver Jute Craft String, So Suzy Stamps; Stars Open Stamp, Little Witch Stamp, Witch Is In Stamp, Web Left Corner, Ranger Distress Oxide Ink; Broken China, Wilted Violet, Faded Jeans, Ranger Archival Ink- Jet Black; Cardstock White and Black; Stickles- Crystal; Scrapbook Adhesives by 3L; Extreme Double Sided Tape, E-Z Runner Grand, 3D Foam Squares

How to:-

- 1) The card base is 5.5x8.5, white cardstock.



- 2) Stamp the witch image on white cardstock using Archival Ink. Using Bisque, add color to all of the witch's skin, no fuse. Using Spring Meadow add color to the witch's stockings, and dress trim, no fuse. Using Tangerine add color to the pumpkin pale and buckles, no fuse. Then add color to the witch's boa using a 4 second fuse. Using Deep Violet add color to the witch's hat, no fuse. Add color to the witch's dress using a 6 second fuse.
- 3) Fussy cut the witch leaving a little white border. Add Stickles to the witch's hat and buckles.
- 4) Cut a piece of white cardstock that is 4x5.25. Using Distress Oxide Inks add colour to that piece of cardstock. Using a thick bristled brush and water, splatter the background, let dry. Stamp the spider web corner using black ink. Stamp "the Witch Is In", in black ink. Adhere to the card base using foam squares. Cut a strip of green paper that is 3.75x1.5, and flag one end. Add burlap string to the top. Adhere to the right hand side of the card, and tuck in a couple of Kraft Tickets.
- 5) Die cut 2 of the Geometric Leaves from black cardstock. Adhere to the right of the green



banner. Adhere the witch to the card using 3D Foam Squares.

6) Stamp stars to the left of the green banner using black ink.
