

Roses Card by

Materials Used: Chameleon Pens: Bubble Gum (PK3), Bisque (NU1), Spring Meadow (YG3), Grass Green (GR3), Warm Sunset (YO3); Stamps: Painted Flowers (Altenew), SSS 101626 Sketch Ranunculus (Simon Says Stamp!), CS-32 Never Say Never (Kesi'art); Ink pads: Versafine Spanish Moss and Onyx Black, Versasmall Opera Pink, Distress Mustard Seed; Neenah Solar White card, Pink card stock; MISTI tool; Stitched Borders (Lawn Cuts); Wink of Stella Clear brush; Pink sequins.

Instructions:

1. Stamp all the elements onto a piece of Neenah white card by using the Opera Pink ink pad for the roses and the Spanish Moss for the leaves. Add small flowers and some yellow little circles.

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2. With Bubble Gum pen, color each petal of the roses, by infusing the brush nib for 3-4 seconds. Repeat with Fawn pen.



3. Fill each leaf with Spring Meadow pen, by infusing the brush nib for 4-5 seconds. Repeat with Grass Green pen, by infusing the brush nib for 6-7 seconds. Add shadows without infusing.

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4. Complete the card by coloring the small flowers and by stamping the sentiment with MISTI tool. Cut the white panel at $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{3}{8}''$ (16,5 x 11 cm), and stitch the long borders with the Lawn Cuts die. For the card base, cut a $13'' \times 4\frac{3}{4}''$ (32 x 12 cm) rectangle from the pink card stock and fold it in half.



5. Add few sequins and the Wink of Stella Clear brush onto the roses.
