



Materials Use: Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe set and Floral Tones in Fuchsia (PK5), Peony Pink (PK4), Spring Meadow (YG3), Grass Green (GR3), Inspired By Stamping Garden Roses stamp set, Versamark Ink, Zing! White embossing powder, vellum, cream cardstock, sewing machine, Versafine Onyx Black ink, sequins.

Instructions:

1. Begin by stamping the rose onto a trimmed piece of vellum. Heat emboss it in white.



2. Turn the embossed piece over and using Spring Meadow (YG3) and the brush nib color the leaves. Using Grass Green (GR3) and the brush nib flick color into the center of the leaves and along one side of the stem.



3. Begin coloring the rose with Peony Pink (PK4) and the brush nib and color the entire flower. Using Fuchsia (PK5) and the brush nib flick color into the areas of natural shadow on the rose.



4. Stamp sentiment and sew the vellum onto a card base. Embellish with sequins.
