



Materials Used: Chameleon Deluxe Color Tones set, Floral Tones set; Grass Green (GR3), Fuchsia (PK5), Peony Pink (PK4), Aqua Marine (BG4), Summer Sun (YL2), Altenew Henna Elements stamp set, Memento Tuxedo Black ink, white Recollections cardstock, a small box, Martha Stewart seam binding ribbon, scissors, Scor-tape.

Instructions:

1. Stamp the flowers and leaves onto white cardstock. Begin coloring the leaves using Grass Green (GR3) and the brush nip infusing for 8 seconds for each side of the leaf. Use pure color for the vein down the middle. Cut out the leaves.



2. Next, color the flowers using the colors Aqua Marine (BG4), Summer Sun (YL2), Peony Pink (PK4) and Fuchsia (PK5). Use the brush nib and infuse for 5-10 seconds for the petals of the flowers. Use pure color from Summer Sun (YL2) for the middle of the flowers. Trim them out and snip in between the petals so that they can be gently bent up.



Arrange flowers and leaves onto the top of the box layering one of the smaller flowers on top of the big flower. Gently bend the petals upward to create dimension. Adhere in place and add ribbon around the box tying in a bow. Arrange the flowers and leaves onto a card base and stamp a sentiment. Adhere the flowers and leaves down and tie ribbon around the bottom section of the card into a bow for embellishment.
