

# Negative Space Coloring

Materials Used:- Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Blue Violet (BV4), Seville Orange (OR4), Altenew Henna Elements stamp set, Memento Tuxedo Black ink, We R Memory Keepers Corner Chomper, sewing machine, American Crafts Dark Gray cardstock, Recollections cardstock.

## Instructions:-

1. Stamp images onto a piece of cardstock. The areas that do not have an image are called the negative space. That is what will be colored in sections and with two colors to create an ombre blend.
2. Using Blue Violet (BV4) and the brush nib infuse for 40 seconds and work from the middle down. Then use Seville Orange (OR4) and the brush nib infusing for 40 seconds and begin coloring by slightly overlapping the lightest blue section and color to the top.



- Stamp the border image in black ink 3 times onto the card front. Using dark gray cardstock cut a mat for the focal image panel and mat. Round the two upper corners of the card.



- Machine stitch the focal panel to the gray mat and adhere onto the card using foam tape.
