

# Spotlighting Card

Materials Used:- Chameleon Color Tones Deluxe Set; Cool Gray (CG8), Warm Sunset (Y03), Summer Sun (YL2), Grass Green (GR3), Sky Blue (BL3), Crimson Red (RD4), Penny Black Centerpiece stamp, Penny Black Sprigs stamp set, Spellbinders Classic Circles die large, Memento Tuxedo Black ink, Ranger Distress Ink in Antique Linen and Vintage Photo, Recollections cardstock, sequins.

## Instructions:-

1. For the spotlight technique decide what part of the image you want to be in the spotlight. Die cut a circle and stamp the image section onto it. On your main panel stamp the entire image. Set aside the fully stamped image.
2. Begin coloring the spotlight section using Cool Gray (CG8) for the bit of the vase. Use the brush nib and infuse for 5 seconds coloring from the middle out on both sides.



3. Color the flower stamen with pure color and the brush nib using Warm Sunset (YO3). Color the centers with the brush nib and pure color using Summer Sun (YL2). Color the bits of the stems and leaves with the brush nib and pure color using Grass Green (GR3).



4. Color one of the flowers and a few buds with the brush nib using Seville Orange (OR4) and infuse for 5-7 seconds. Using Sky Blue (BL3) and the brush nib color another flower and 2 more buds infusing for 5 seconds. Deepen shadows with pure color. Color the remaining flower and buds using Crimson Red (RD4) and the brush nib infusing for 5-7 seconds.



5. Adhere the spotlight colored die cut to the full image. Add some Distress ink in Antique Linen and Vintage Photo to the edges of the card. Add machine stitching around the edge. Embellish with sequins.
